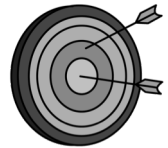

**3. You aren't sure how the story ended.**

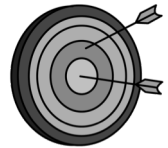
- A. Read the last few sentences again.
