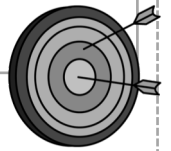

Analyze and Evaluate

To **analyze** means to look closely at something to understand it better. To **evaluate** means to make a judgment or decide if something is good, bad, important, or useful.

Analyze Questions:

1. Who are the characters?

The group of friends and the injured bird.

2. What was the problem?

The group found a small injured bird during their hike.

3. What did the group do to solve the problem?

They took the bird to a nearby animal rescue center.

Evaluate Questions:

1. Do you think the group made the right decision to help the bird? Why or why not?

Yes, the group made the right decision because helping an injured animal shows kindness and responsibility.

2. Would you have done something different if you were part of the group? Explain your answer.

Answers will vary. Example:

No, I would have done the same because it's important to care for injured animals.

Yes, I might have called the animal rescue center instead of leaving the hike to take the bird there.
