Direct Quotation

A **direct quotation** gives a speaker's exact words. To show a direct quotation, follow the rules below:

Rule 1: Capitalize the first word, and use a comma to set off a direct quotation from the other word.

Rule 2: At the beginning of a quotation, put the comma plus a space outside the quotation marks.

Rule 3: At the end of a sentence, put a comma or other or other punctuation inside the quotation marks.
