Sentence Structure

Sentence structure is how all the parts of a sentence fit together.

There are four types of sentence structures in English.

- 1. Simple sentence:** a sentence which contains a subject and a verb.
- 2. Compound sentence:** two independent clauses joined by a coordinating conjunction (for, and, or, but)
- 3. Complex sentence:** an independent and one or more dependent clauses joined by a subordinating conjunction (after, although, until, when) or a relative pronoun (who, which).
- 4. Complex-compound sentence:** two independent clauses and one one more dependent clauses.
