Comparative and Superlative Adjectives

When we compare people, places, or things, we can use **comparative** or **superlative adjectives**.

Rule 1: Add **-er** to an adjective to compare **two nouns**.

Example: James is taller than Ben.

Rule 2: Add **-est** to an adjective to compare **more than two nouns**.
