An **open syllable** ends with a vowel.

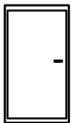
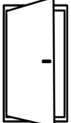
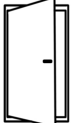
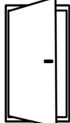
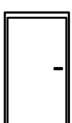
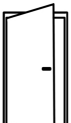
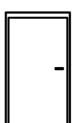
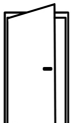
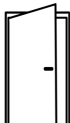
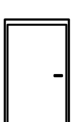
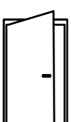
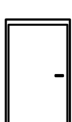
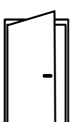
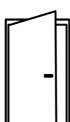
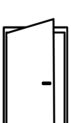
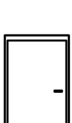
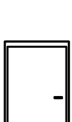
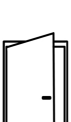
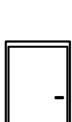
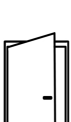
