Subordinating Conjunctions

Subordinating conjunctions are words that connect two parts of a sentence. They help explain when, why, or how something happens. Some common subordinating conjunctions are **because, when, if, before, after, while, and until**.

Examples:

I stayed home because it was raining.

She went to bed after she finished her homework.
