

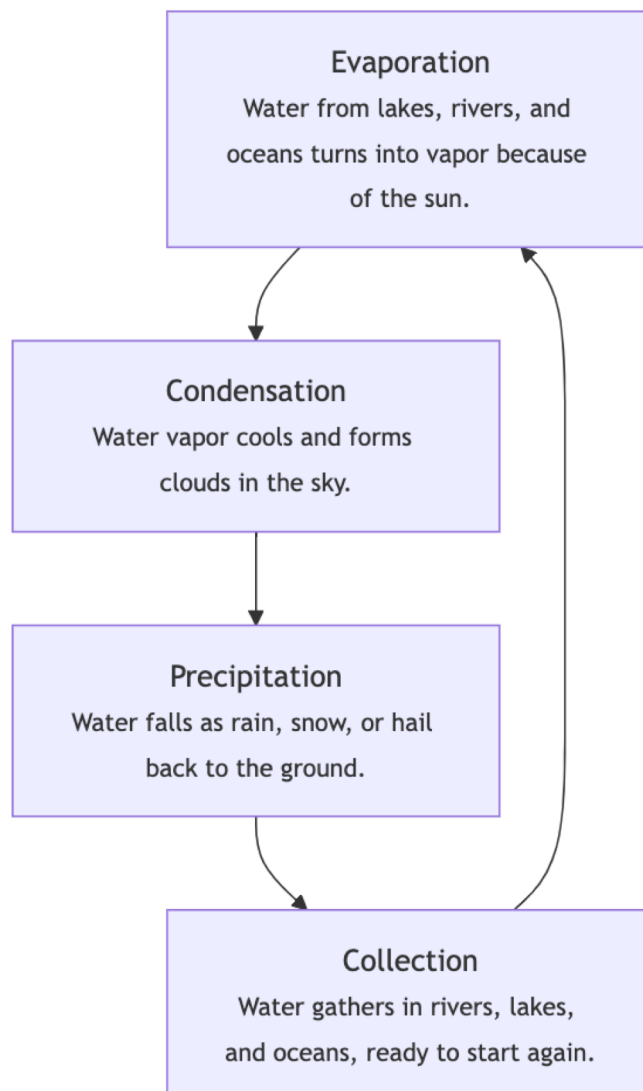

3. Why did the author use a flow diagram instead of just writing sentences?

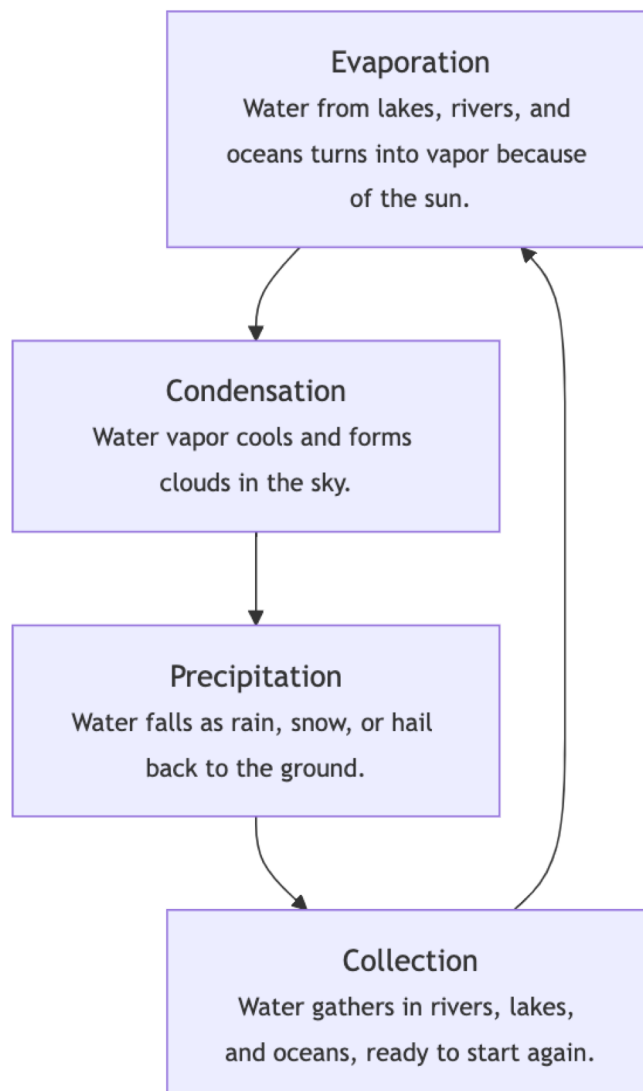
