Metaphor

A **metaphor** is a figure of speech that directly compares two things by saying one *is* the other (e.g., "Time is a thief"), while a **simile** compares two things using "like" or "as".

Example:

A **simile** uses "like" or "as" to compare two different things.

A **metaphor** describes one thing as if it were something else.
