Subject-Verb Agreement: Compound Subjects

A **compound subject** is a subject that consists of two or more nouns or pronouns joined together by a conjunction, such as *and* or *or*. It's important to ensure that the verb agrees with the subject correctly.

- **Joined by "and":**
Treated as plural → Use a plural verb.
- **Joined by "or/nor":**
Verb agrees with the closest subject.
- **Special Cases:**
Collective nouns: Singular or plural depending on context.
Mixed singular/plural: Focus on the nearest noun for verb agreement.
