Differences Between Thesaurus and Dictionary

Dictionary defines word meanings, pronunciations, and usage.

Thesaurus groups synonyms/antonyms to expand vocabulary and refine expression.

Both are essential for precise communication.

Examples:

Dictionary: Defines "book" (printed pages).

Thesaurus: Lists synonyms (volume, tome).
