Elliptical Constructions Using "So" or "Neither"

Elliptical constructions are sentences or clauses where certain words are omitted because they are understood from the context. "So" and "neither" are often used to combine the sentences. "**so**" is used to show agreement with a positive statement, while "**neither**" is used to show agreement with a negative statement. See the example below:

Wordy Sentences: *I like pizza. Linda likes pizza.*

Combined: *I like pizza. So does Linda.*
