Vague and Ambiguous Pronouns

A **vague pronoun** occurs when a pronoun could refer to more than one noun in the sentence.

Example:

*When Susan and Ruby finally landed, **she** breathed a sigh of relief. In **the sentence**, “she” is vague — it could mean Susan or Ruby.*

The pronoun in bold is ambiguous. Underline all of its possible antecedents.
