Specialized Compound Words

Compound words are formed by combining two smaller words to create a new word with its own meaning. While the meanings of the smaller words can give you clues, the true meaning of a compound word often depends on the context in which it is used.

Example: The word "greenhouse" combines "green" and "house," and it refers to a glass building used for growing plants.
