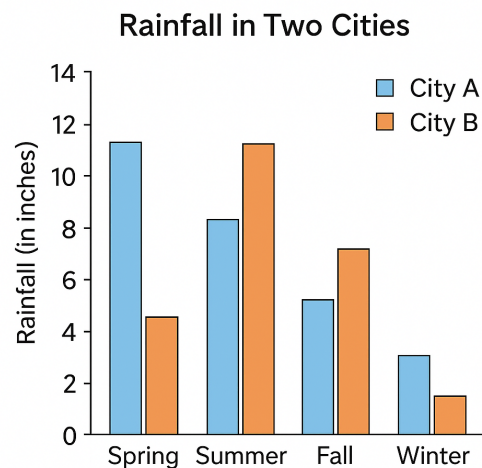
Evaluate Text and Graphic Features for Meaning

 - D. It shows how rivers are formed.

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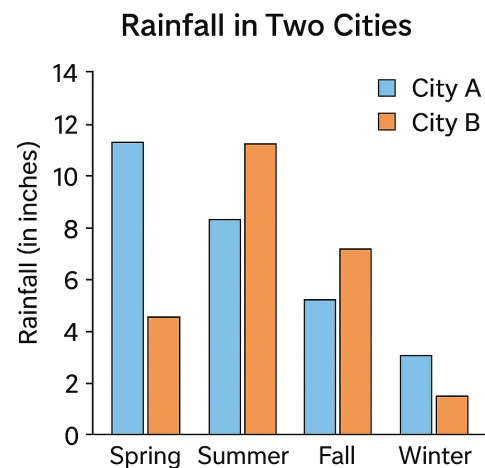
