How to Make Connections

When reading, try to think about things that relate to the text by making connections:

1. **Self to Text (S-T):** Link something in the text to your own experiences or knowledge.
2. **Text to Text (T-T):** Relate the text to something else you've read or seen before.
3. **Text to World (T-W):** Connect the text to a real-world problem or issue.
