Uses of Gerunds

A gerund is a word that looks like a verb but acts as a noun.

Examples:

Swimming is my favorite hobby. (Gerund as the subject)

I enjoy **running** in the park. (Gerund as the object)

She is good at **painting**. (Gerund after a preposition)
