Syllable Division

Syllable division is the way a word is split into smaller parts, called syllables. Each syllable has one vowel sound, and dividing words into syllables makes them easier to read and pronounce. Words can be divided into syllables using simple rules: Split between two consonants (hap-py), after the first vowel in V/CV patterns when followed by one consonant (ti-ger), or before the second consonant in VC/C patterns when followed by two consonants (win-ter).
