The Sounds of Cc and Gg

The letters c and g can make two different sounds: hard sounds and soft sounds. A soft c sounds like /s/, and a soft g sounds like /j/. **Soft c and g** usually appear before the vowels e, i, or y.

Example:

Soft c: city Soft g: gym
