Syllable Division: VC/CV and V/V Patterns

Syllable division is how we break words into smaller parts, called syllables. **VC/CV Pattern:** When two consonants are between vowels, the syllables usually split between the consonants. **V/V Pattern:** When two vowels are next to each other but make different sounds, the syllables split between the vowels.
