

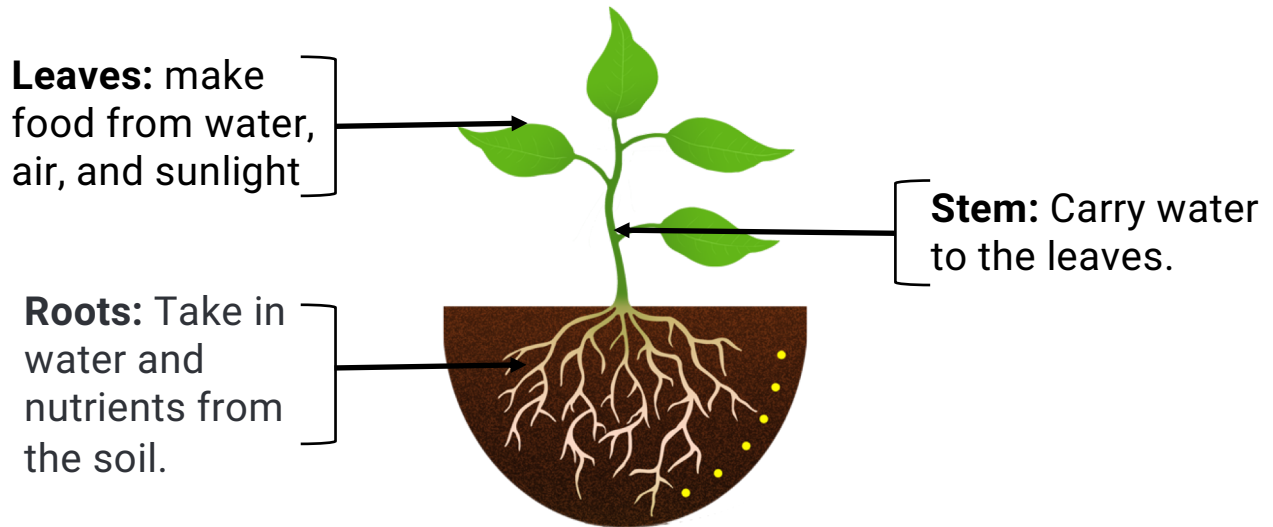

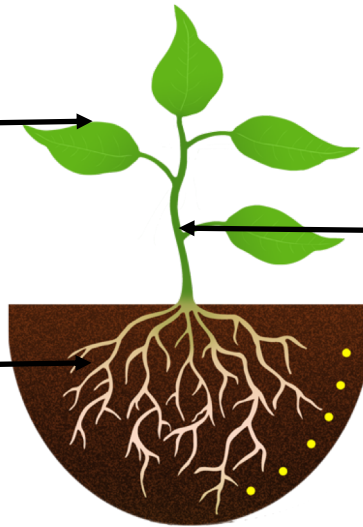

Leaves: make food from water, air, and sunlight

Roots: Take in water and nutrients from the soil.



Stem: Carry water to the leaves.

First, roots take the water from the soil.

Next, the stem carries water to the leaves.

Last, leaves make food with water, air and light.
