Types of Sentences

There are four types of sentences, and each has a special purpose. **Declarative sentences** make a statement and end with a period. **Interrogative sentences** ask a question and end with a question mark. **Exclamatory sentences** show strong emotion and end with an exclamation mark. **Imperative sentences** give a command or request and end with a period or exclamation mark.
