## Distinguish Subject and Predicate

The **subject** is who or what the sentence is about. It tells us the “doer” or the “topic.” The **predicate** tells what the subject does or describes something about the subject. It always includes a verb.

**Example:**

The cat slept on the bed. (Subject: The cat, Predicate: slept on the bed.)
