“Be” and “Have” in Present and Past Tenses

The verbs be and have change forms in different tenses. In the present tense, **be** becomes am, is, are, and in the past tense, it becomes was, were. For example: I am happy (present) and I was happy (past). The verb **have** is have or has in the present tense and becomes had in the past tense.

Example:

She has a dog (present) and She had a dog (past).

“Be” and “Have” in Present and Past Tenses - Answer Key
